



## TIRE STEWARDSHIP OF SASKATCHEWAN

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - August 2017

#### **Will I need a new Retailer Agreement with the TSS?**

Yes. A new Retailer Registration Application and associated Terms and Conditions has been provided in this package. Please complete and return this form to the TSS as soon as possible by email, fax or mail. If you misplace the paper copy of this application, you can also find it on the TSS website.

#### **Will I get a new TSS Remittance Form?**

Yes. You have been provided a new Remittance Form in this mail package. This form and other information is also available anytime on the TSS website. The form is similar to the one used previously by SSTC.

#### **Will I still have the same Registration Number?**

Yes. For ease of transition, the TSS will continue to use the same registration numbers that were previously assigned to retailers by SSTC. When filling out your TSS Retailer Registration Application, please use your same registration number in the form as noted. If you are a new retailer registering with the program for the first time with the TSS, you will be assigned a new number.

#### **Will my remaining tire credits I had on my account with SSTC transfer to the TSS?**

Yes. SSTC will be transferring its tracking system to the TSS, along with retailer balances of existing credits so collection can continue as normal.

#### **Can I continue to do Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) for remitting my fees?**

The TSS will work with retailers that were set up on EFT previously with the SSTC to get the same functionality in place with the TSS. If other retailers are interested in getting set up on using EFT to remit fees, rather than through cheque, please contact the TSS at [accounts@tirestewardship.sk.ca](mailto:accounts@tirestewardship.sk.ca).

#### **Who do I remit or forward tire recycling fees to?**

##### **Fees charged to August 31, 2017:**

All fees charged and collected to the end of August should continue to be forwarded to the SSTC by the September 20th deadline. They will process these fees and apply credits to retailers for collection by the end of September.

##### **Fees charged from September 1, 2017 and forward:**

After September 1, all tire recycling fees charged and collected by retailers should be forwarded to the TSS as the new program operator. We will continue using the deadline of the 20th day of the following month. So the first remittance you will send to the TSS will be in October for September fees collected.
